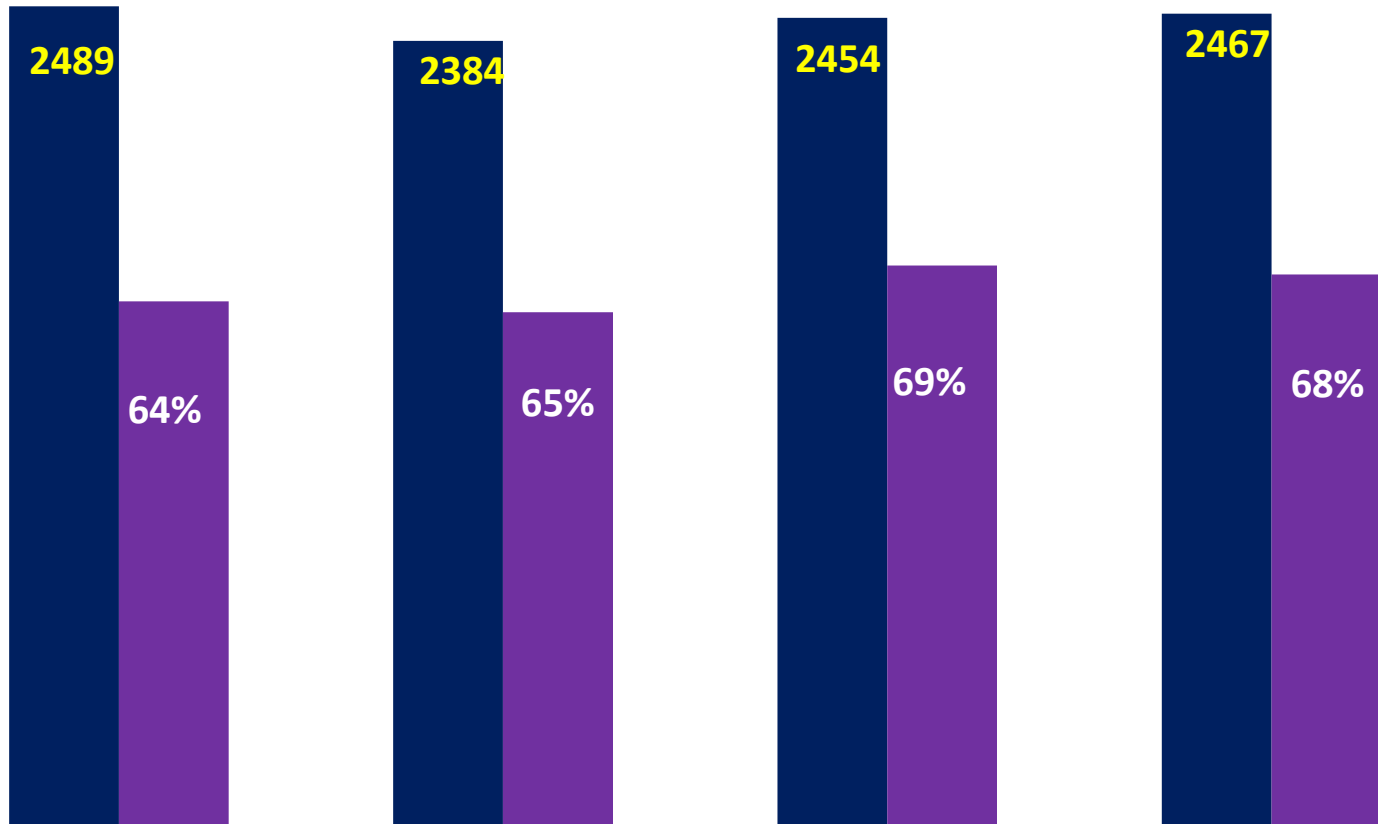

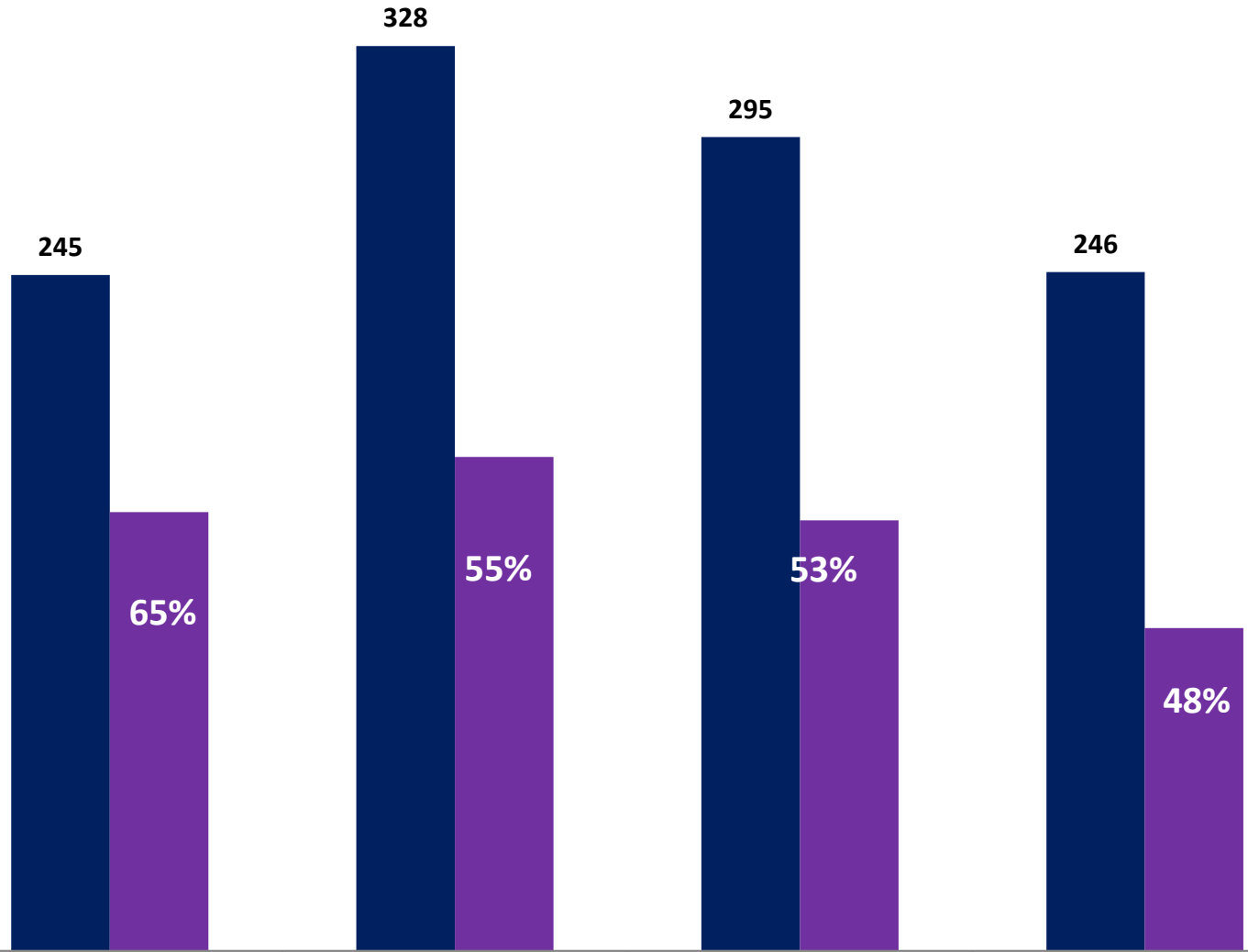


Grant Rate for Regular Hearings & Hearing Officer Reviews

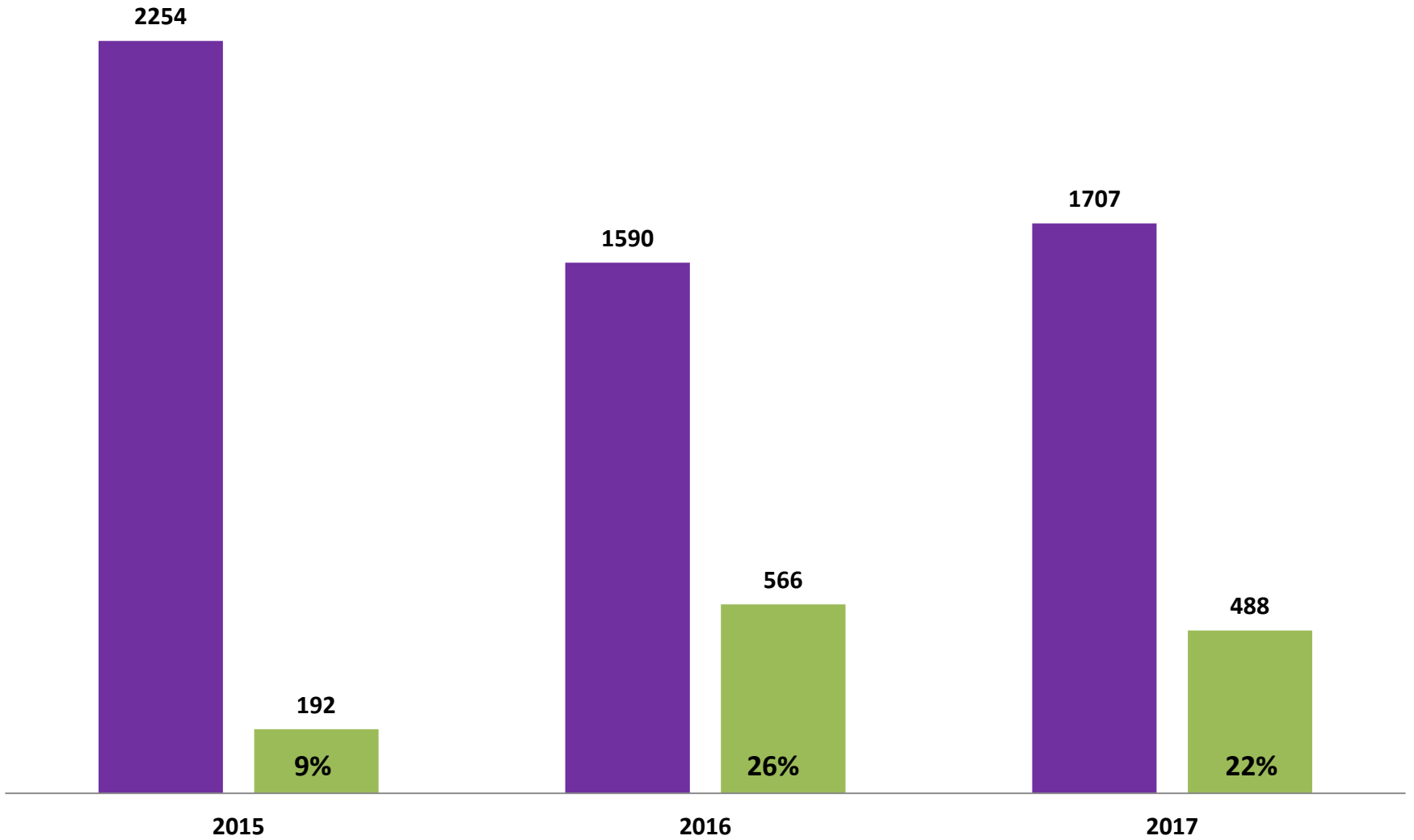
Grant Rate for Early Discharge Requests



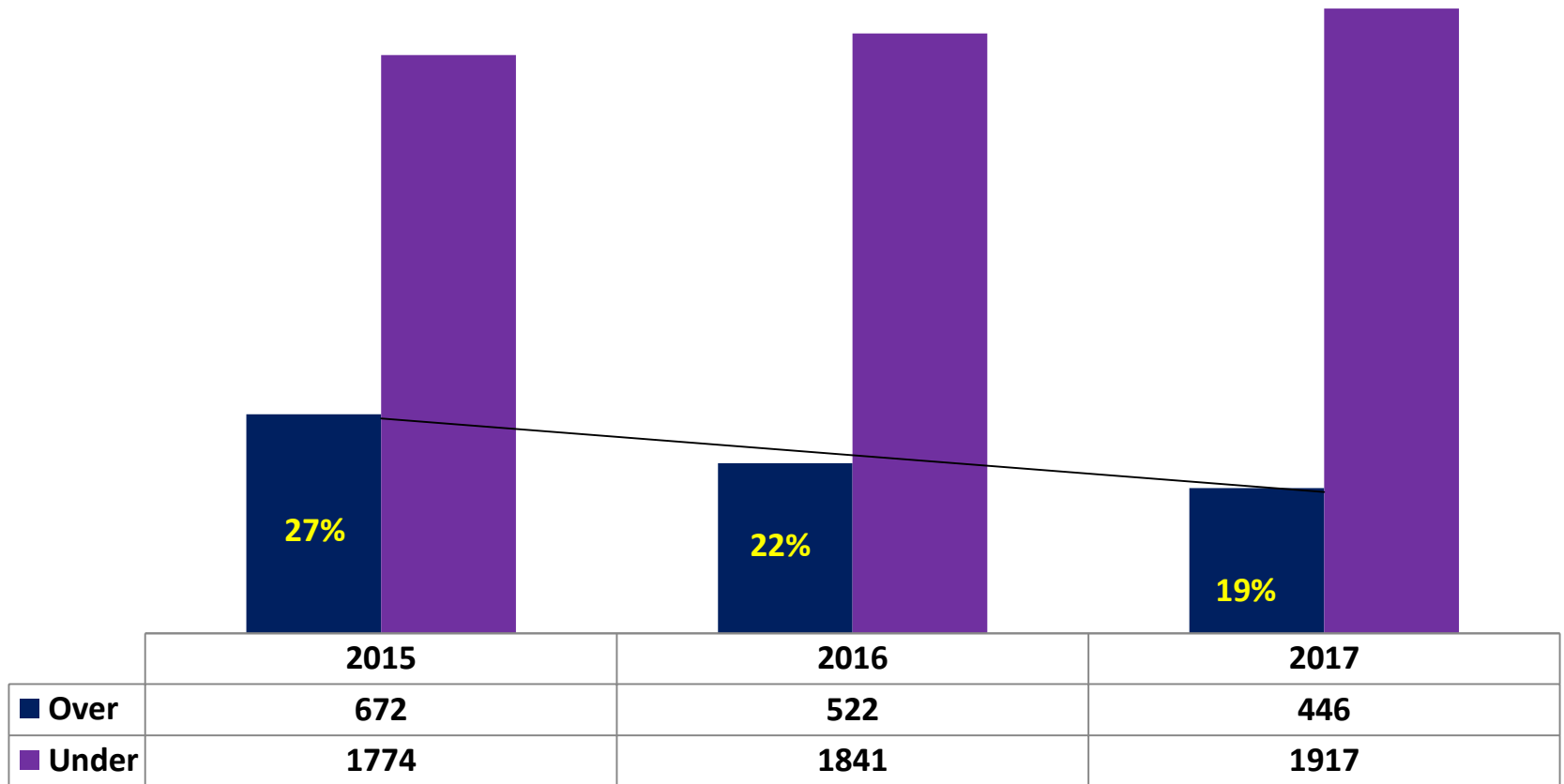

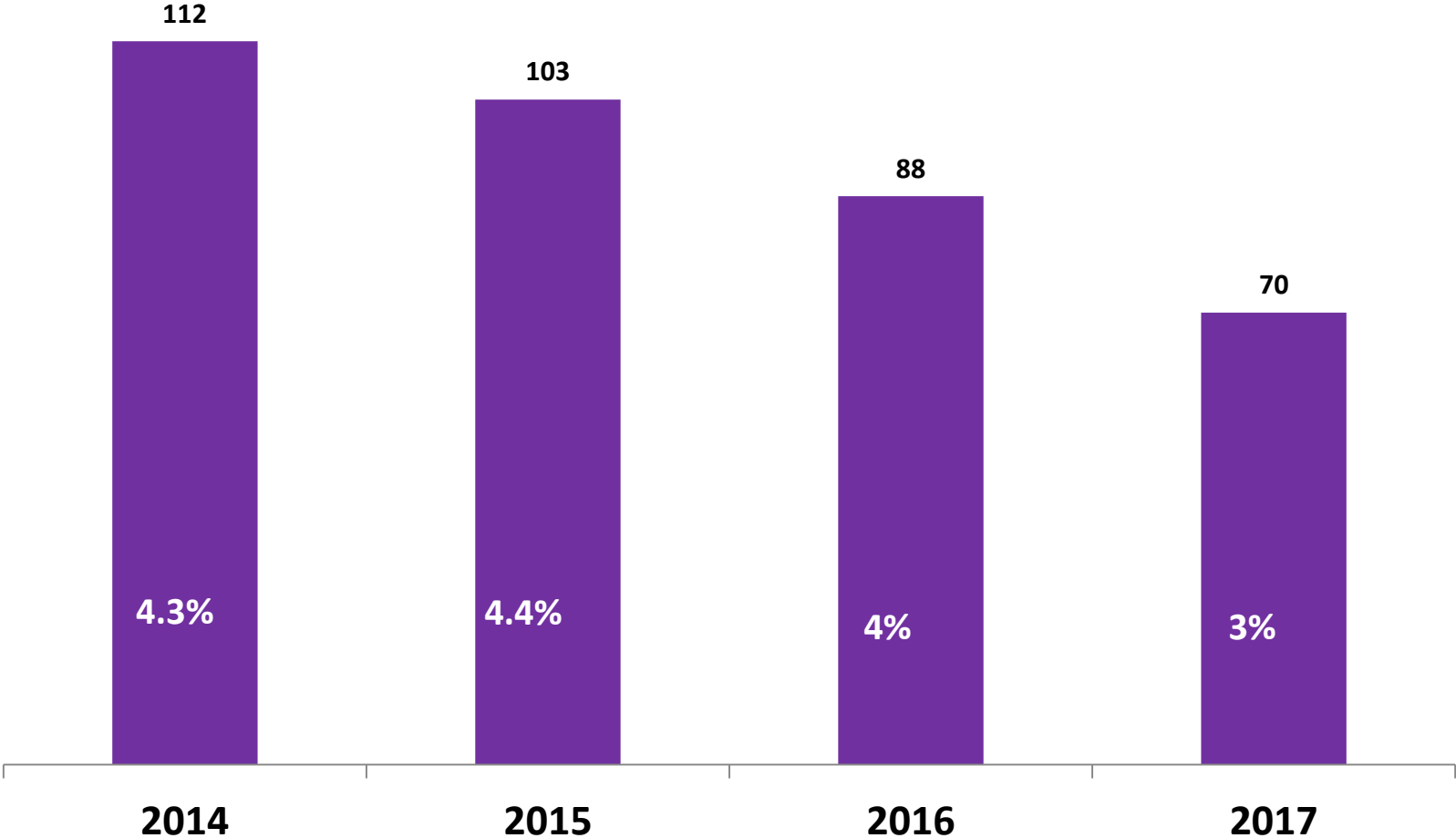

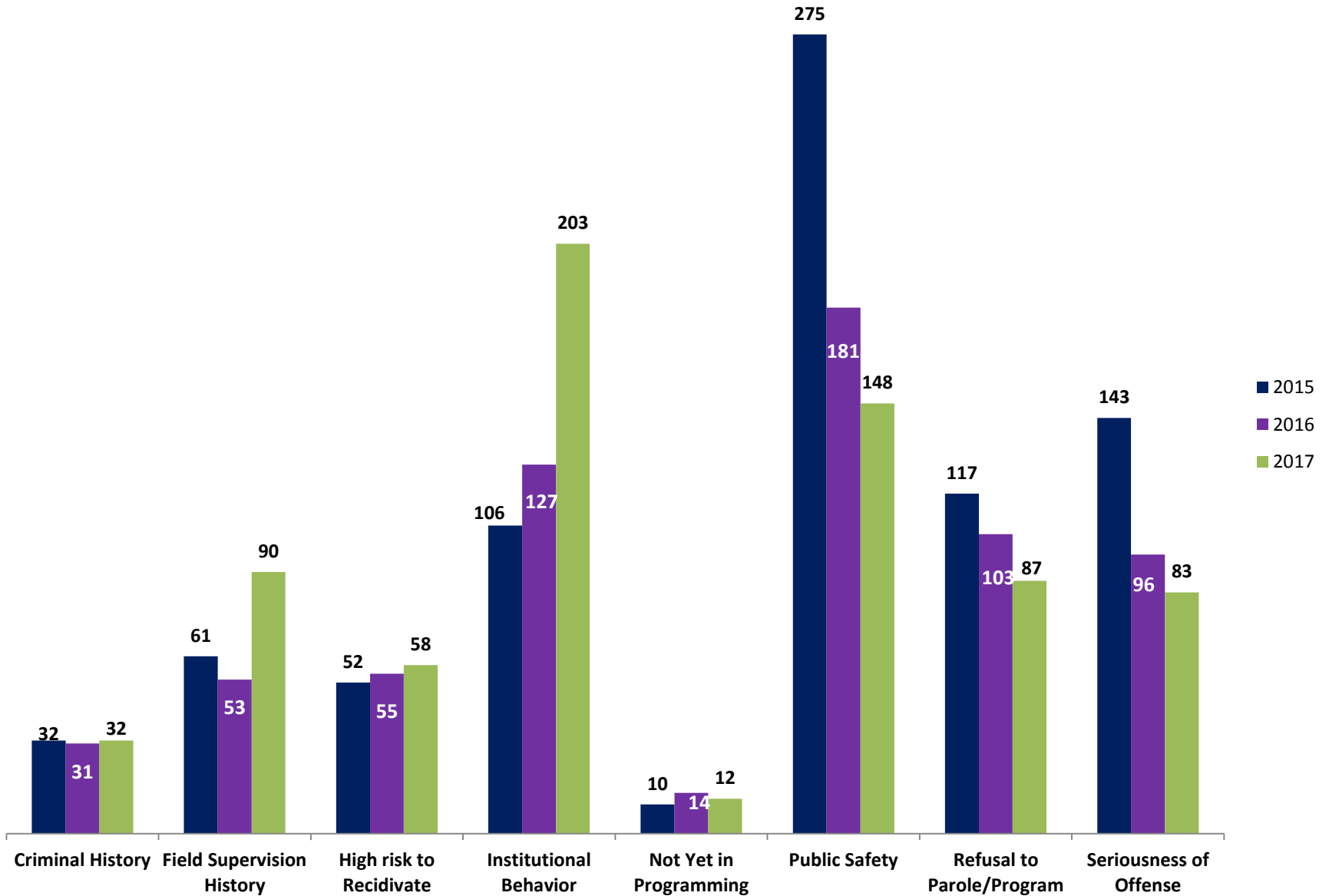
Offenders who have served 150% of fixed sentence at time of Commission Hearing



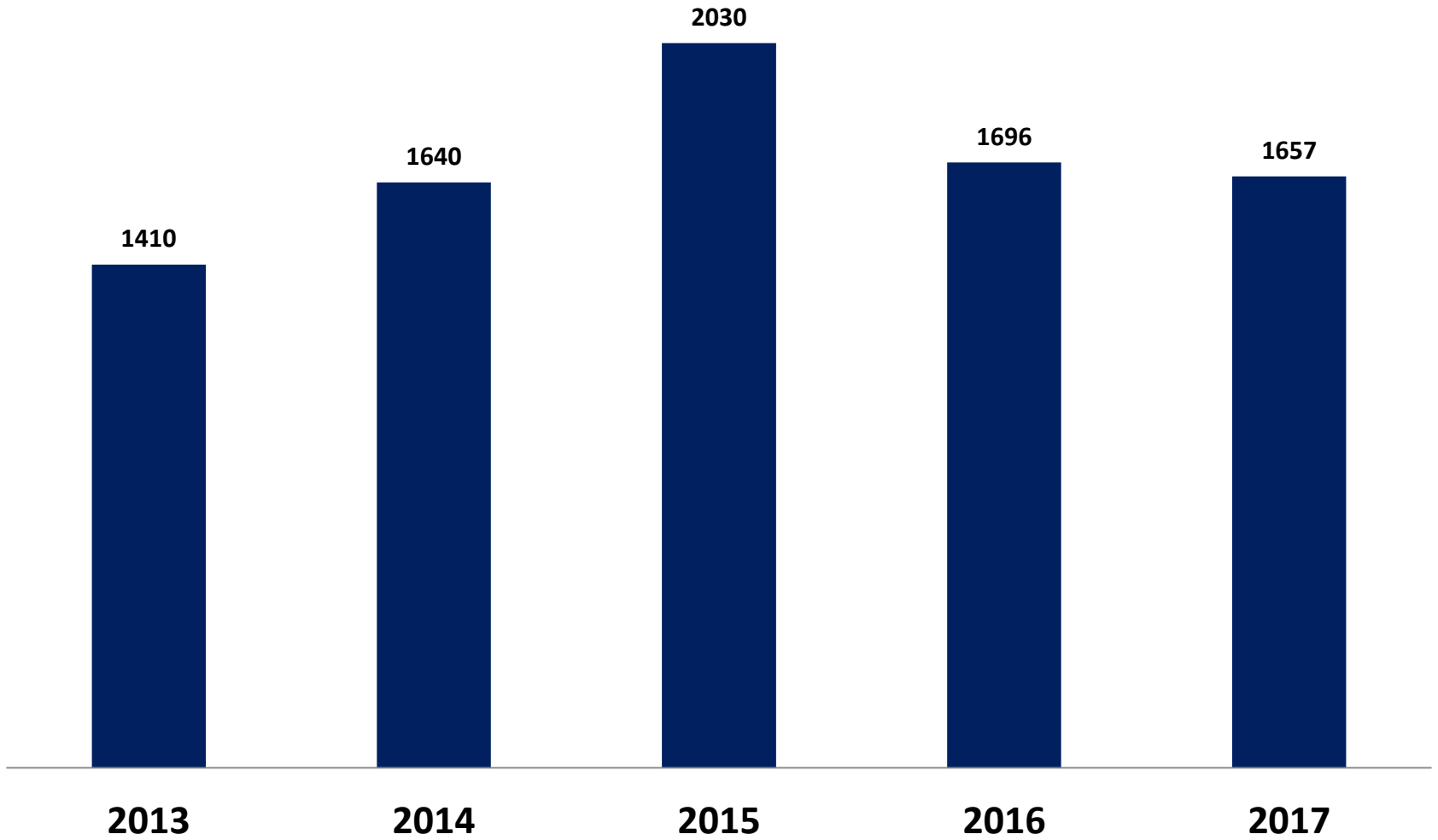
Offenders Refusing Parole



Frequency of Denial Reasons



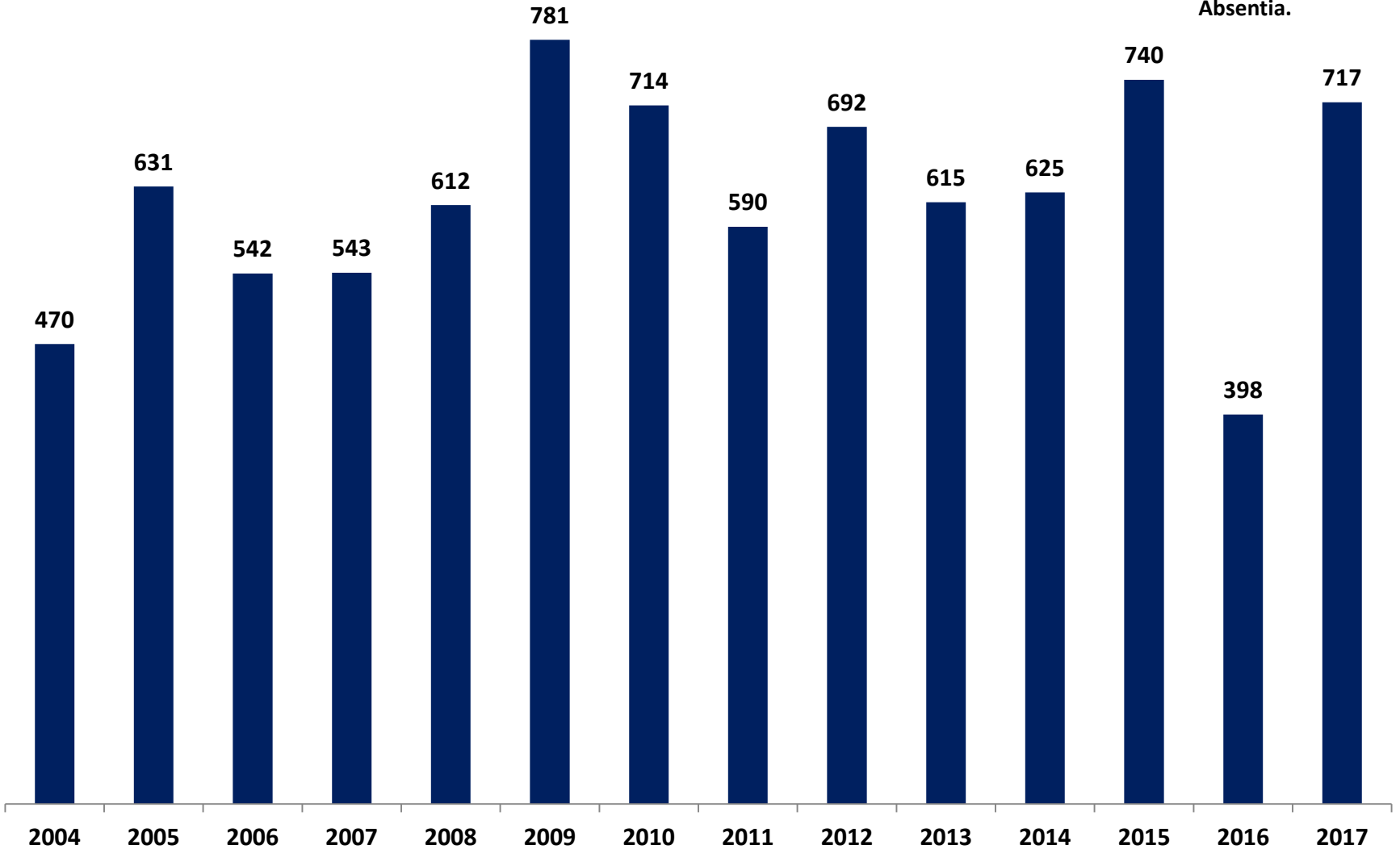
Total Parole Contract Releases by Year



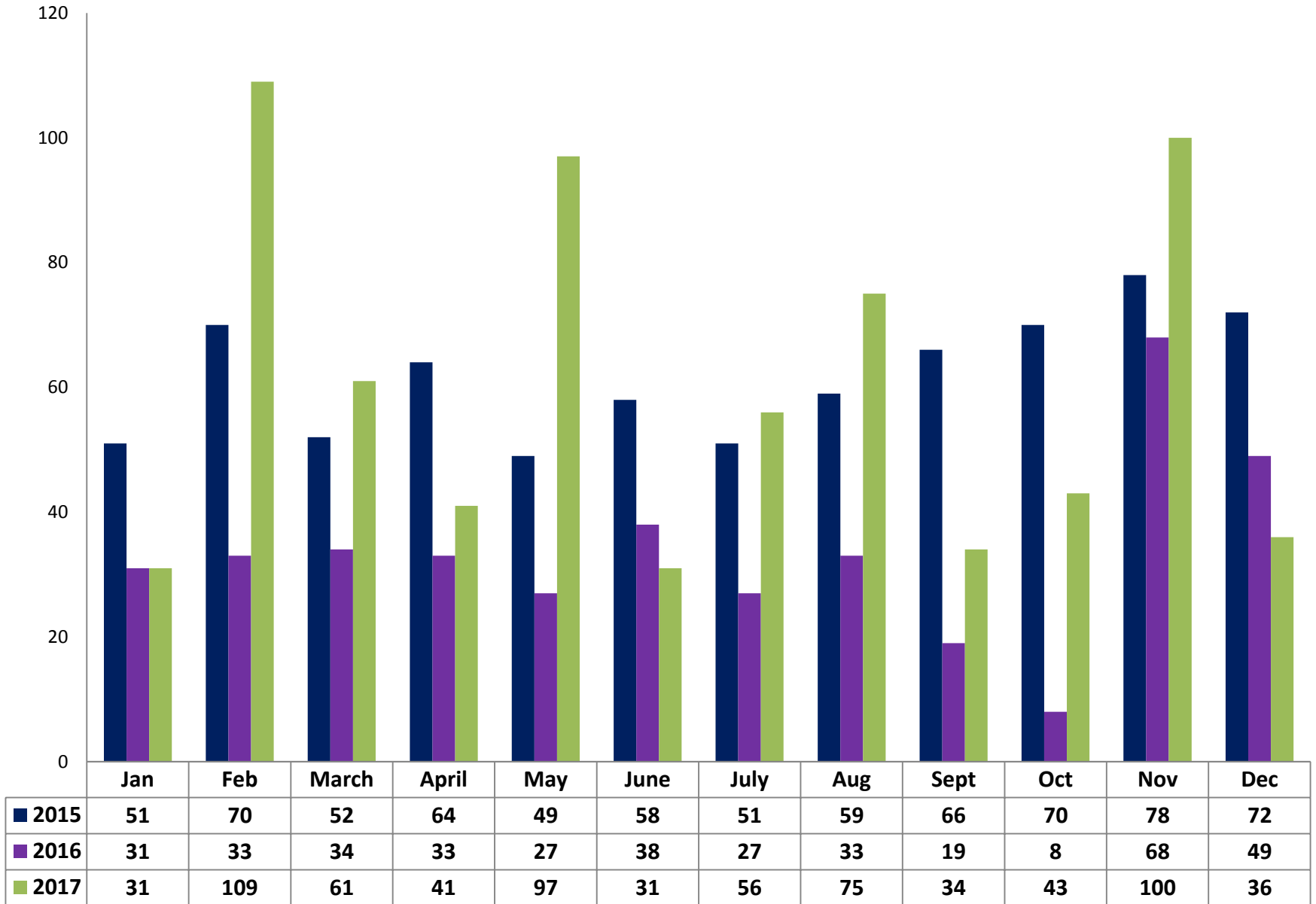

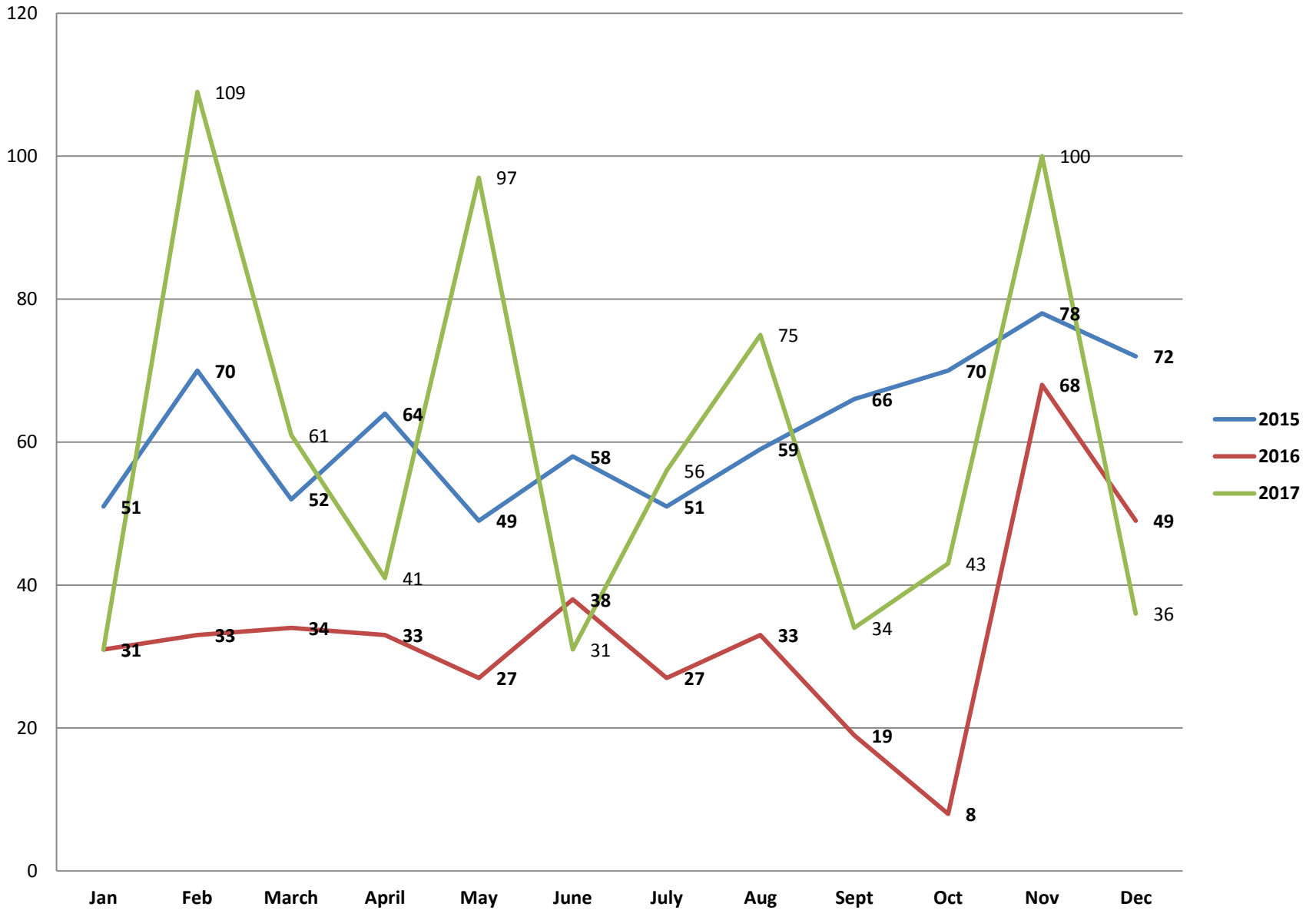

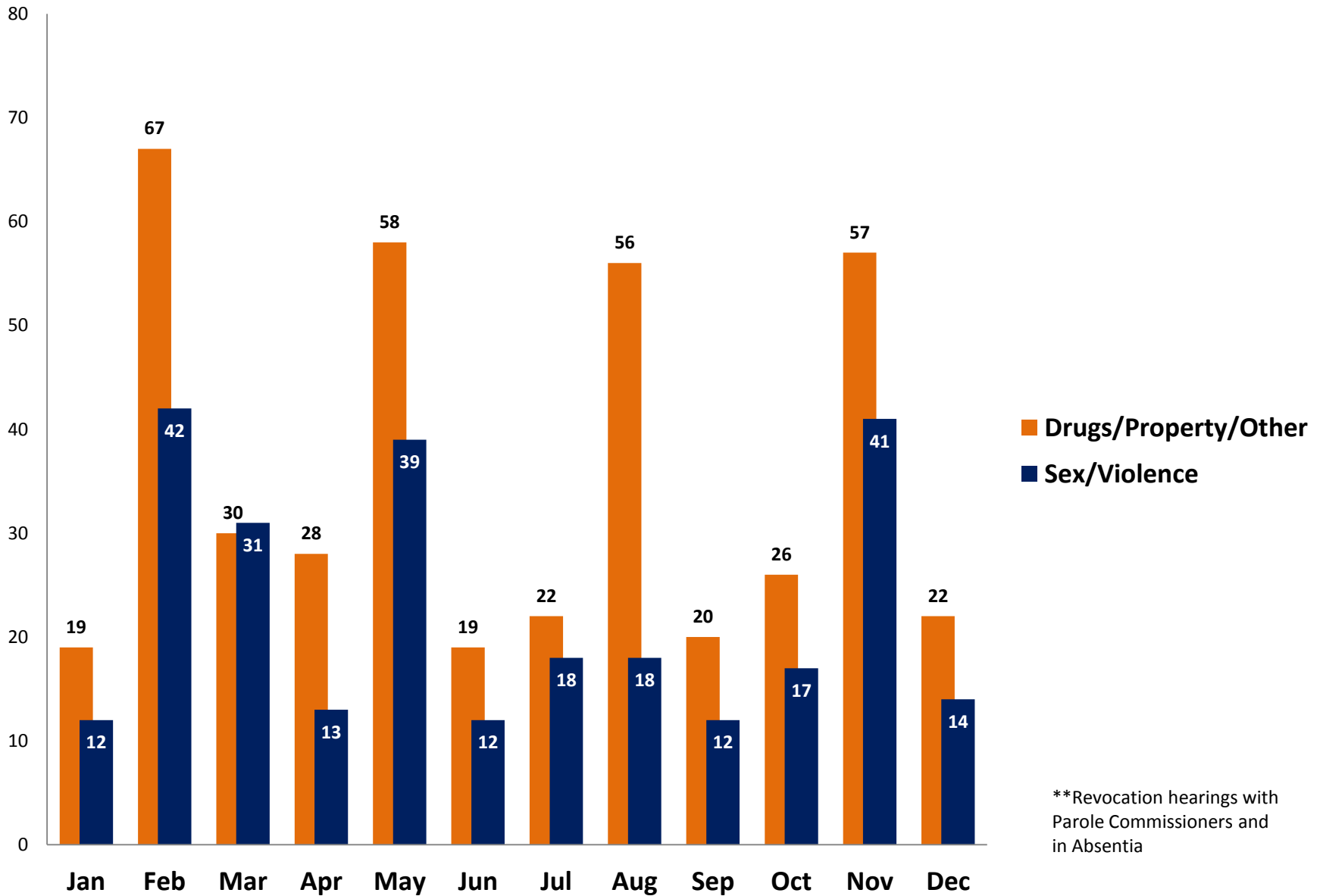
Commission Revocation Hearings by Month

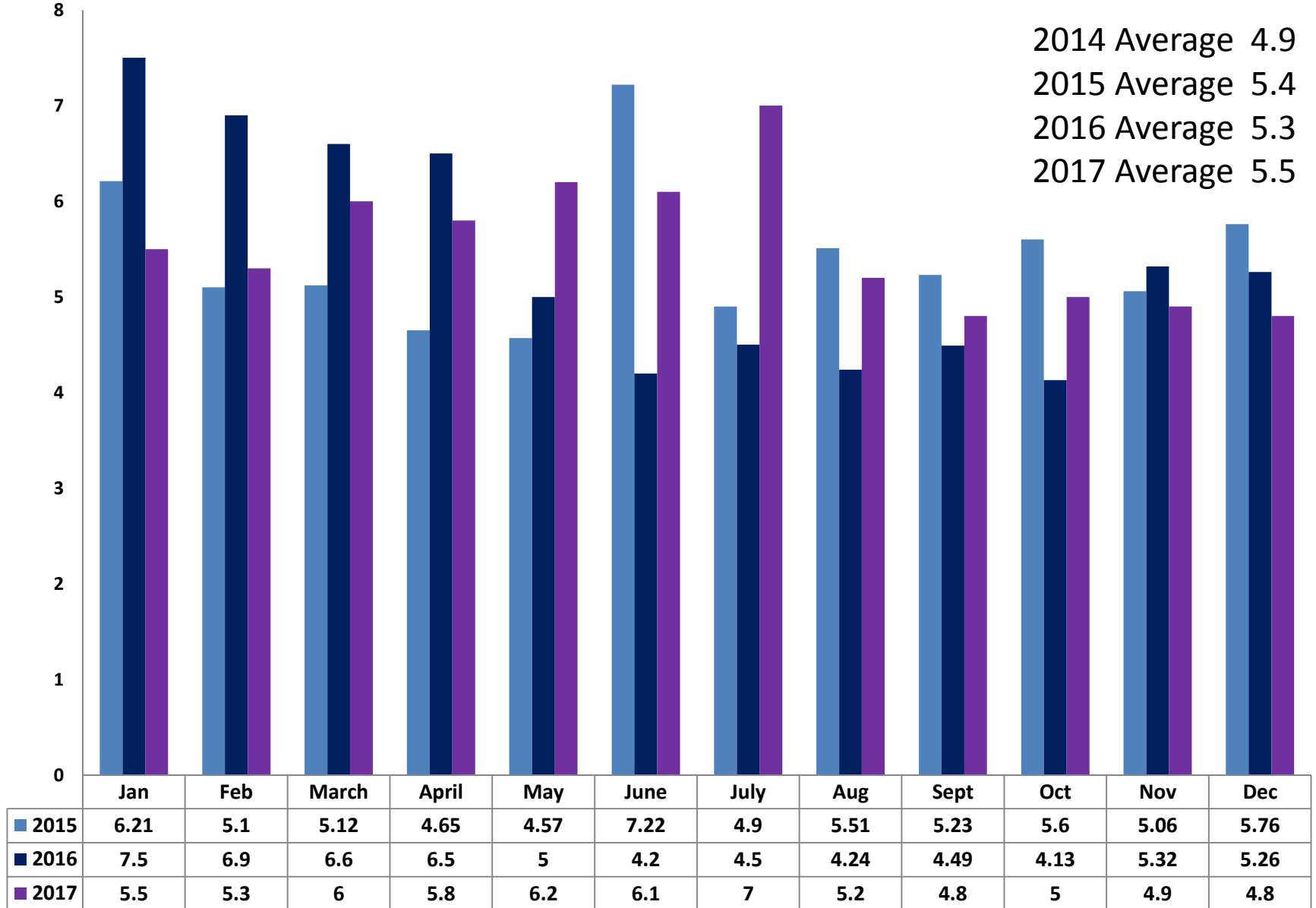


Revocation Hearings by Original Conviction Offense Type**



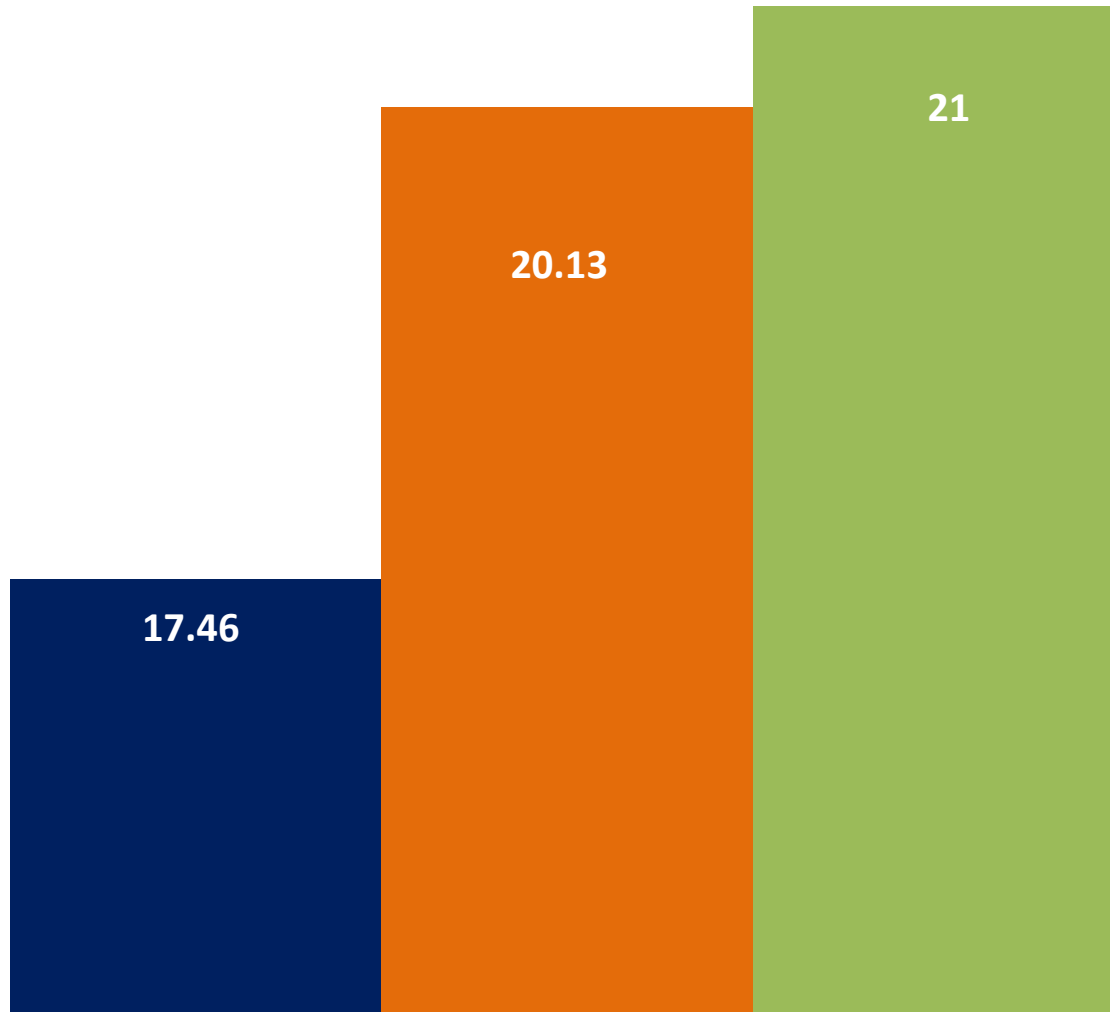

Revocations: Months in Custody from Arrest to Commission Hearing

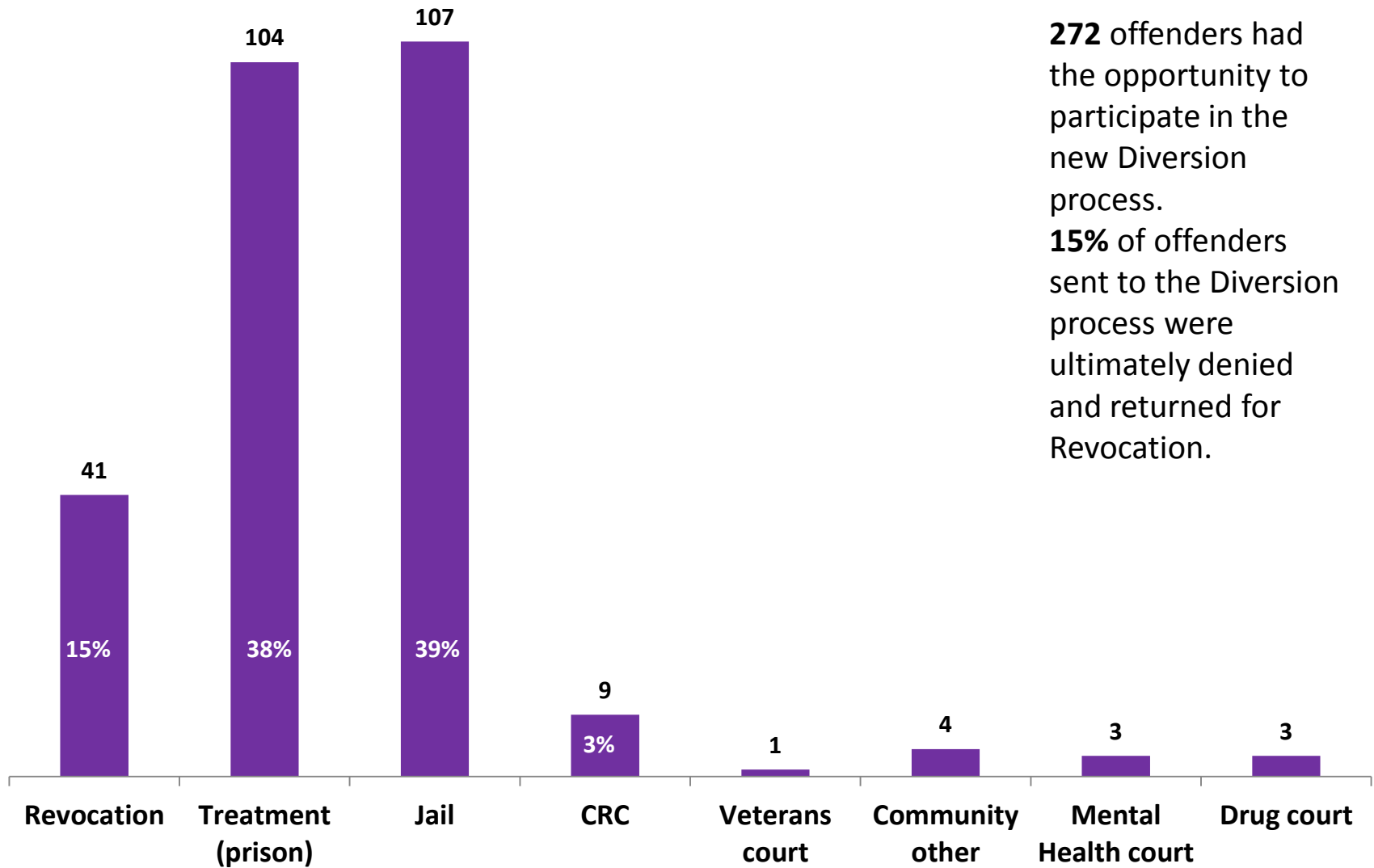


Average Months on Parole
